



MEDIA ACCREDITATION PASS RULES & RESTRICTIONS

Mainstream Media means a domestic Media Organisation whose primary content does not relate to basketball and that has major national, state and/or regional coverage.

Basketball Media means a domestic Media Organisation whose primary content relates to basketball and primary medium of publication is digital, including but not limited to online web or social media.

Basketball Organisations means media staff, employees and representatives of an Organisation whose primary content relates to the delivery or management of basketball operations. It also includes partners of Basketball Victoria including the PlayHQ platform (domestic competitions and programs, tournaments and events, VJBL and CBL), integrated third-party providers such as Teampay or Glory League (if used by your association or club), Synergy Sports and OwnurGoal (for NBL1 participants) or refbook (for referees and all technical officials).

With respect to all activities that are marked as **PERMITTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS** in the table below for Mainstream and Basketball Media, that activity is permitted for the purpose of News Reporting / editorial only.
