

## **TRIBUNAL CHAIRPERSON'S CHECKLIST**

- Ask the reported person if there is any objection to any of the Tribunal members sitting (17.4)
  If there is objection to a Tribunal member hear and rule on the argument (17.4)
  Advise reported person and reporting official of their right to remain in the hearing at all times except when the Tribunal is making a decision (17.5)
- Advise all persons of the method of recording the hearing
- Read the charges in the presences of all persons (17.7)
- Ask the reported person if the charges are understood (17.8)
- Ask the reporting person if the charges reflect their intention (1.8)
- Take the reported person's plea (17.9)

Introduce the Tribunal members (17.3)

- □ If a team is reported, ask if there is a spokesperson (17.2)
- Exclude all witnesses until they give their evidence (17.11)
- Hear evidence of the reporting official (17.12)
- Allow reported person to ask questions of the reporting official (17.12)
- Hear evidence of reporting person's witness(es) (17.12)
- Allow reported person to ask questions of reporting person's witness (es) (17.12)
- Hear evidence of reported person (17.14)
- Allow reporting official to question reported person (17.14)
- Hear evidence of reported person's witness(es) (17.14)
- Allow reporting official to question reported person's witness(es) (17.14)
- Exclude all persons while deliberating on guilt (17.18)
- Call all persons back and invite reported person to make submission on penalty if found guilty of any offence and ascertain if there have been prior offences. (17.22, 17.24, 17.25)
- Exclude all persons while deliberating on penalty (17.25)
- □ Invite all persons in for decision on penalty (17.26)
- Complete and hand to reported person "Penalty and Appeals Advice" form
- Complete and send to BV "Tribunal Hearing Report" form
