Basketball Victoria Awards are made after considering nominations from Associations. They are not linked to TOC awards.



Technical Officials Commission Awards - General Criteria

Note: General Criteria to be used unless stated otherwise within the criteria of the award.

1. All individual award winners

- **Must be based in Victoria**
- Must be registered and financial with the BV TOC.
- Must be active official within the TOC (Referee Coaches must have current accreditation).
- Must not have been found guilty by a BA, BV, TOC (including Member Protection) Tribunal during the period 12 months preceding the award.
- Must not be owing money, nor have current legal action pending with BA, BV or TOC.
- Conducts themselves appropriately (punctual, reliable, always in correct uniform & displays appropriate attitude).
- Senior is defined as over 23 years of age.
- Junior is defined as 23 years of age and under as at 31st December in the year of the award.

2. Branch / Association award winners

- Must be affiliated and financial with BV TOC.
- Must not be owing money, nor have current legal action pending with BA, BV, TOC or their Association.
- Financial members recorded as of 30th September of the current year.

3. Selection

- TOC (VBRA) nominations for Awards will be reviewed by TOC (VBRA) Awards Committee with final selections being made by TOC.
- TOC (VBRA) Awards - TOC (VBRA) Committee Members have ability to nominate additional nominees and in event of none being received from Branches or Associations.
- Nominations for Life Membership will be researched and confirmed by the TOC (or a subcommittee) prior to submission to the Awards Committee.

4. Nomination

- The following awards require nominations from the Branch (President or Secretary) or Association (President or Secretary):
 - TOC Domestic Metropolitan Referee Branch of the Year (Small, Medium or Large), Metropolitan Domestic Referees of the Year Awards (Small, Medium, Large), Advisor/Educator of the Year & Recognition of Service Award.
- The following awards require data for the relevant criteria from the TOD:
 - International, National and Interstate Referee Award, Level Awards, AJC Referee Awards, Most Improved Country Referees, Outstanding Achievement Awards – Country, Outstanding Referee Development Programs – Country.

As part of the process, the CEO and Operations Manager of Basketball Victoria will be notified of the recipients by the TOC.



Definitions:

State Level: MUVJBL, BVC Country Championships, MMBL, CBL, Big V and higher leagues or equivalent.

TOC: Technical Officials Commission is the group of elected Commissioners plus two nominated positions from Basketball Victoria.

TOD: Technical Officials Department are the BV staff allocated for the Technical Officials Commission.

Branch: Groups of active members who are responsible for acting as Technical Officials at one or more basketball association(s)

TOC (VBRA) Award Criteria

- **TOC (VBRA) International (FIBA) Referee of the Year – Henry Perazzo Award**
 - The highest performing referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the level of appointment by FIBA (FIBA ranked events) as well as National and State appointments.
 - Currently refereeing in an elite National, Interstate or State League.
 - Mentors other officials as appropriate.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
 - Is not eligible to win another League Level Award.

After the International Referee of the Year award has been decided, League Level Awards for Metropolitan and Country referees are selected.

- Referees who win League Level awards may have previously received a League Level Award.
- Eligible referees must be currently refereeing in an elite league.
- The award is based on the League data relating to performance from the relevant level (including availability)

- **TOC Metropolitan National (NBL/WNBL) Referee of the Year – Wally Pattison Award.**
 - Currently refereeing in an elite league (International, National or State),
 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the level of appointment at International, National and or State Leagues.
 - Currently refereeing in a National (NBL, WNBL) Interstate (NBL1) or State League (Big V)
 - Mentors other officials as appropriate.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Country National (NBL/WNBL) Referee of the Year – Bob Scott Award.**



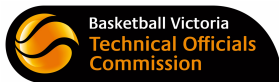

 - The highest performing Country referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the level of appointment at International, National and or State Leagues.

 - Mentors other officials as appropriate.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Metropolitan Basketball Victoria (NBL1) Referee of the Year – Paul Wiltshire Award.**

 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee in the nominated calendar year.

 - Currently refereeing in elite Interstate League (NBL1)
 - The highest performing Country referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the level of appointment at Interstate (NBL1) – Majority of appointments at Interstate League Level.
 - Mentors other officials as appropriate.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Metropolitan Level 3 Referee of the Year – Allan Manhire Award**
 - Currently refereeing in the elite Senior State League (Big V – Youth Championships and above)
 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the best level 3 appointments at State Leagues. (Big V) Including availability, finals results, and season performances
 - Awarded to the highest ranking finals appointments referee (taking into account special circumstances)
 - Data to be obtained from the relevant league for that nominated season.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Country Level 3 Referee of the Year – Rod Bush Award.**
 - Currently refereeing in the elite Senior State League (Big V – Youth Championships and above)
 - The highest performing Country referee in the nominated calendar year.

 - Data to be obtained from the relevant league for that nominated season.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Metropolitan Level 1 Referee of the Year – Bill Mildenhall Award.**
 - Currently refereeing in the elite Junior State League (VJBL)
 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the best level 1 appointments at Junior State Leagues. (VJBL) Including availability, finals results, and season performances
 - Awarded to the highest ranking finals appointments referee (taking into account special circumstances)
 - Data to be obtained from the relevant league for that nominated season.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Country Level 1 Referee of the Year – John Turner Award.**
 - Currently refereeing in the elite Junior State League (VJBL)
 - The highest performing Country referee in the nominated calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the best level 1 appointments at Junior State Leagues. (VJBL) Including availability, finals results, season performances



- Awarded to the highest ranking finals appointments referee (taking into account special circumstances)
 - Data to be obtained from the relevant league for that nominated season.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Metropolitan AJC Referee of the Year - Steven Chadd Award**
 - Currently refereeing in the elite State Leagues
 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee in the nominated AJC calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the highest placed appointed medal game at an AJC event (except for U/14) Selection order - Gold medal game at any level – Bronze at highest age level.
 - Data to be obtained from the AJC event for that nominated season.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC Country AJC Referee of the Year - Gail and Jimmy Ralph Award.**
 - Currently refereeing in the elite State Leagues
 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee in the nominated AJC calendar year.
 - Performance is based on the highest placed appointed medal game at an AJC event (except for U/14) Selection order - Gold medal game at any level – Bronze at highest age level.
 - Data to be obtained from the AJC event for that nominated season.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award.
- **TOC (VBRA) Metropolitan Referee Coach of the Year – Ron Burgess Award**
 - Licensed, accredited Grade 3 (or above) metropolitan referee coach.
 - The highest performing Metropolitan referee coach in the nominated calendar year.
 - Currently appointed by the TOD to State League games on a regular basis.
 - Account taken of number of appointments, timely submission of Jotforms, Game Reports, review of the quality of Jotform reports.
 - In the event of a tie, account can be taken of involvement in higher leagues.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award
- **TOC (VBRA) Country Referee Coach of the Year – Alan Garraway Award**
 - Licensed, accredited Grade 3 (or above) country referee coach.
 - The highest performing Country referee coach in the nominated calendar year.
 - Currently appointed by the TOD to State League games (Big V, VJBL, CBL) on a regular basis.
 - Account taken of number of appointments; timely submission of Jotforms, Game Reports, review of the quality of Jotform reports.
 - In the event of a tie, account can be taken of involvement in higher leagues.
 - Is eligible to win irrespective of previously winning the award
- **TOC (VBRA) Metropolitan Referee Advisor of the Year – Neil Bradbury Award**



- Has regular attendance at TOC Referee Advisors/Educators meetings.
- Has been an active advisor for more than 3 years.
- Demonstrates a working relationship with the TOC (VBRA) & the Branch.
- Conducts effective Referee, Referee Mentor and Referee Coach Development Programs.
- Coordinates education materials to be shared to all officials.
- Has met criteria for VJBL Quota (where applicable).
- Additional effective initiatives have been implemented by the Advisor.

- **TOC Country Referee Educator of the Year – Bill & Ray Hunt Award.**

- Attendance at a minimum of one TOC Referee Advisors/Educators meeting in a year.
- Has been an active referee educator for more than 3 years.
- Demonstrates a working relationship with the TOC (VBRA) & the Country Development Officer.
- Conducts Referee, Referee Mentor and Referee Coach Development Programs in conjunction with the Country Referee Development Officer.
- Coordinates education materials to be shared to all country officials.
- Demonstrates effective education and training initiatives for country referee education.
- Has not been the recipient of this award previously

- Selected by the Score Table Officials Association

- **TOC Metropolitan (VBRA) Referee Branch of the Year**

Criteria of Size Breakdown

- Size of branch to be determined by number of registrations held by an association by the date of 30th of November in the previous calendar year.
- Each category is split into groups of
 - Large – Top 13 Branches
 - Medium – Middle 13 Branches
 - Small – Remaining branches
- Each branch shall be notified of the category they are eligible to nominate for the following year via email on the 1st Monday of each December

Criteria input from the Branch:

- Have an effective Referee, Referee Mentor, Referee Coach Development Program.
- Active qualified Referee Advisor (Metropolitan).
- Details of recognition and recruitment indicatives.
- Details of management of branch funds.
- Details of complaints and grievance process.

Considerations given to:

- Circumstances unique to Association - e.g. Females, Older people, Inclusive Program, Disability, Wheelchair Program.
- Sponsorship in place or actively being sought,



- Communication (Newsletter, Web Page, Facebook and/or Referee Manager),
- Referee Amenities – room, security and fridge,
- Mission Statement,
- Social activities,
- Referee welfare
- Unique referee education and training processes

The following factors are taken into consideration from TOC data:

This award goes to an individual (male) referee who has achieved outstanding results in respect to their performance during the nominated period.

To be eligible for this award, the recipient must:

- Be under the age of 23 yrs at the 31st of December in the year nominated
- Have exhibited a high level of commitment to both development and game
- Have exhibited some/all of the following positive qualities on and off the court: leadership, team work, communication, commitment, loyalty, work ethic, ambassadorship, respect for teams, coaches and other officials

Helen Pawsey Award - Outstanding Achievement by a Female Referee

This award goes to an individual (female) referee who has achieved outstanding results in respect to their performances during the nominated period.

To be eligible for this award, the recipient must:



- Have exhibited a high level of commitment to the development of the game
- Have exhibited some/all of the following positive qualities on and off the court: leadership, team work, communication, commitment, loyalty, work ethic, ambassadorship, respect for teams, coaches and other officials.

Dennis Morgan Award for outstanding Achievements by a Junior Female Referee

This award goes to an individual (female) referee who has achieved outstanding results in respect to their performance during the nominated period.

To be eligible for this award, the recipient must:

- Be under the age of 23 yrs at the 31 December in the year nominated
- Have exhibited a high level of commitment to both development and game
- Have exhibited some/all of the following positive qualities on and off the court: leadership, team work, communication, commitment, loyalty, work ethic, ambassadorship, respect for teams, coaches and other officials

John Holden Award - Outstanding Development of Referees at a Large Association

To be eligible for this award, the recipient must:

- Be an Affiliated Association of BVC
- Must have current Affiliation Agreement with BVC
- Must operate the BVC Online Registration system in accordance with BVC processes and procedures
- Referees at the Association participate in the BVC Referee License process annually
- Association has over 1,500 registered participants as determined by the BVC Database

The nomination may consider the following areas:

- Referees retention and growth
- Referee recruitment
- Referee development plan
- Contribution within a region
- Contribution to BVC activities and various leagues
- Significant referee appointments during the nominated period ie. National Championships.

Gerald Carstairs Award - Outstanding Development of Referees at a Medium Association

To be eligible for this award, the recipient must:

- Be an Affiliated Association of BVC
- Must have current Affiliation Agreement with BVC
- Must operate the BVC Online Registration system in accordance with BVC processes and procedures
- Referees at the Association participate in the BVC Referee License process annually
- Association has less than 1,500 registered participants.

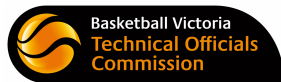

VBRA Distinction Awards

• TOC (VBRA) LIFE MEMBERSHIP

The criteria for Life Membership, of the Technical Officials Commission is as follows: -

- I. The nominee must have completed a minimum of twenty-five (25) years of continuous active service within the TOC (VBRA) structure. Consideration may be made for interruption of continuity due to circumstances beyond the control of the nominee. The nominee must have been a financial member of the TOC (VBRA) for the period of service.
&
- II. The nominee must have participated and contributed to the promotion of officiating and officials at State level for a minimum of fifteen (15) years in a combination of one of the following capacities:
 - o Metropolitan or Country Victoria Official Administration
 - o Metropolitan or Country Victoria Official Coaching / Education&
- III. The nomination must be signed by the TOC Branch President and Secretary, or two TOC Commissioners, or where there is no formal Branch, by the President and Secretary of the Basketball Association of the nominee.
- IV. TOC to form a sub-committee to meet with nominee to discuss credentials and suitability for life membership

No more than 2 (two) Life Membership nominations will be awarded in any given year

- Unless under special circumstances no more than 2 (two) Life Member nominations will be awarded in any given year

No more than 1 (one) Life Member nomination will be considered from any one Branch/Association in any given year.

Should the nominee be granted the award, his/her name shall be inscribed on the TOC (VBRA) Life Member's Board and they will be provided with a medallion, plaque and framed certificate.

• TOC (VBRA) RECOGNITION OF SERVICE AWARD

The criteria for a Recognition of Service Award, is as follows: -

A nomination for a "Recognition of Service Award" of the TOC (VBRA) shall:

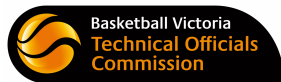
- I. The nominee must have completed a minimum of fifteen (15) years of continuous active service with a branch(s) or affiliated Associations of the TOC (VBRA). Consideration may be made for interruption of continuity due to circumstances beyond the control of the nominee.
&
- II. The nominee must have been a financial member of the TOC (VBRA) for the period of service.
&
- III. The nominee must have held a leadership position within the Branch or Association for a minimum of ten years and have participated in a leadership role in Technical Official development or administration. Allowance may be made for nominations from areas which do not have a formed Branch or Executive.
&
- IV. The nomination must be signed by the TOC (VBRA) Branch President and Secretary, or two TOC Commissioners, or where there is no formed Branch, by the President and Secretary of the Basketball Association of the nominee.

No more than 4 (four) Recognition of Service nominations will be awarded in any given year.



No more than 1 (One) Recognition of Service nomination will be considered from any one Branch/Association in any given year.

Should the nominee be granted the award, his/her name shall be inscribed on the TOC (VBRA) Recognition of Services Award Board and they will be provided with a framed certificate.



- **TOC (VBRA) WALL OF FAME**

CATEGORY 1:

Nomination is available for all Technical Officials who qualify as follows:

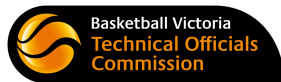
- I. Held a FIBA licence for a minimum of ten (10) years.
- II. Has retired from active officiating (domestic level excluded).
- III. Has represented Basketball Australia as an FIBA appointed Technical Official at:
 - a. Two Olympic Games or
 - b. One Olympic Games and one senior men's or women's World Championship or
 - c. Three senior men's or women's World Championships.
 - d. Was a licensed member of the TOC (VBRA) during the period of such appointments.

CATEGORY 2:

Nomination is available for all Technical Officials who have served the TOC (VBRA) over an extended period and would be seen to be iconic in the State of Victoria by members. Qualifications must include:

- I. Being a Life Member of the TOC (VBRA).
- II. Having been awarded the BV 50-year service award.
- III. Has retired from active officiating (domestic level excluded).
- IV. Has made an outstanding contribution to basketball Technical Officials in the State of Victoria throughout the extended period by meeting a minimum of three (3) of the following requirements:
 - a. Senior position on TOC (VBRA) (Board or Committee of Management in the past)
 - b. Technical Official Education at the National League level.
 - c. Technical Official Coaching at the National League level.
 - d. State representation at Australian Junior Championship events as a Technical Official.

A maximum of two (2) nominations will be considered for the Wall of Fame award by the TOC Commissioner's in any one year.
